Update of the I-5 Corridor Project

The Interstate 5 North Coast Corridor Project extends 27 miles on I-5 from La Jolla Village Drive in San Diego to Harbor Drive in Oceanside/Camp Pendleton.

The proposed freeway improvements are only one part of a larger regional effort to improve transportation in the North Coast Corridor.

Proposed freeway improvements have an estimated cost between \$3.3B to \$4.5B. Project complexities include crossing six coastal lagoons and passing through five cities.

Our speaker will discuss the ongoing environmental process as well as the unique opportunities and challenges this project presents.
